1	Lima			<p>Arrival in Lima, meeting &amp; transfer to the selected hotel.</p> <p>Guided tour of the Colonial and Modern Lima including the "Plaza Mayor" (main square) where the Government Palace, the Cathedral and the City Hall are located surrounded by colonial streets that shows why downtown Lima is considered a world heritage. Then proceed to the residential district of San Isidro and the modern Miraflores, in front of the Pacific Ocean where the nightlife is concentrated.</p> <p>PM Guided visit of the Gold Museum which contains a splendid private collection belonging to the Mujica Gallo family with unique objects of pre-hispanic art, as well as many priceless pieces in gold, copper and silver.</p> <p>(NOTE: depending of time arrival of passengers, this tour could be provided the last day at Lima)</p> <p>Accommodation.</p>	 B
2	Lima  Cusco			<p>American or buffet breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>AM Transfer to the Lima airport and flight departure by the selected airline</p> <p>Arrival in Cuzco, meeting and transfer to the hotel.</p> <p>Morning at leisure to rest &amp; get adjusted to the altitude ( 11,000 feet a.s.l. ) or just stroll on your own.</p> <p>PM Guided visit of the city including the main square and the Cathedral and the nearby ruins of Q'enko, PucaPucará, Tambomachay &amp; the Sacsayhuamán fortress.</p> <p>Evening free to enjoy the "Cuzco night lighting". Accommodation.</p>	 B
3	Cusco			<p>American or buffet breakfast at the hotel</p> <p>Full day excursion to the small village of Písac with its indigenous and handcrafts market and the Inca fortress of Ollantaytambo with lunch included.</p> <p>( this excursion takes place only on Tuesdays, Thursdays or Sundays )</p>	 B  L
4	Cusco  Km 104  Wiñaywayna Machu Picchu  Aguas Calientes			<p>American or buffet breakfast at the hotel</p> <p>We pick you up from your hotel in order to direct us to the train station to board the train to the KM. 104 of the railroad to Machu-Picchu, where we begin our walk.</p> <p>After approximately two hours of walk, we will have a rest and lunch, and then continue toward Wiñaywayna where we will camp. We will have a guided visit of this important archaeological center. Lunch, dinner and camping.</p>	 B  L  D
5	Aguas Calientes  Cusco			<p>Breakfast and beginning of the walk/trek to Machupicchu arriving to the sector of Inti Punku, from where we will appreciate the citadel of Machupicchu. We will register our arrival to this citadel. After spending some time at the lookout point, we descend to the ruins and briefly explore some areas close to the trail.</p> <p>Lunch included.</p> <p>PM : Train journey back to Cusco. Arrival and transfer from the station to the hotel. Accommodation</p>	 B
6	Cusco  Puerto Maldonado			<p>American or buffet breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>AM ransfer to the airport for your flight departure to Puerto Maldonado ( 30 mintes ).</p> <p>Arrival in Puerto Maldonado, meeting and transfer from the airport to the river port. A motor canoe journey takes you to the very jungle to reach your elected lodge for accommodation.</p> <p>PM After lunch and a brief rest to avoid the early afternoon heat, you will enjoy a jungle excursion to enjoy the incredible nature which is considered one of the world's top 10 bio diversity 'Hot Spots' - species - rich area of tropical rainforest.</p> <p>Evening canoe ride, dinner and accommodation.</p>	 B  L  D
7	Puerto Maldonado			<p>Breakfast at the lodge.</p> <p>Jungle excursions. Lunch, dinner &amp; accommodation at the lodge.</p>	 B  L  D
8	Puerto Maldonado Cusco			<p>Breakfast at the lodge.</p> <p>PM Motor canoe transfer back to Puerto Maldonado and transportation to the airport for your flight back to Cusco. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.</p> <p>Rest of the day free to stroll on your own or go shopping. Accommodation.</p>	 B

9	Cusco			American or buffet breakfast. Transfer to the bus station for a journey of about 8 hours to reach Puno enjoying a beautiful landscape and andean scenery. ( Train can be provided instead of bus ) Lunch will be included. Arrival in Puno and transfer to the selected hotel and accommodation.	B L
10	Puno			American or buffet breakfast. Early start for a full day tour beginning with the Uros Indian floating islands made entirely of "totora" reeds. These indians descend directly from the original lake dwellers and have maintained their traditional life style and customs. Transfer to the Juliaca airport, on the way, guided visit of Sillustani, an archaeological site near Lake Umayo. It is well known for the great number of "chullpas" or funerary towers of different shapes and sizes which contains the remains of Colla nobles, a race descended from the Tiahuanaco civilization Flight departure back to Lima. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.	B
